

Technical Rider: *Apocalypse and Aloha*

1. Cast Requirements

- **Total Cast Size:** 6 – 7 Actors.
- **Character Breakdown:** Typically 3 Male and 4 Female roles (one can double), including specific archetypes such as the local surfer (Danny), the young musician (Blue), the East Coast government operative (Burnzie), the immunologist (Frankie), and traditional Hawaiian characters (Lokelani and Jazz).

2. Scenic & Set Design

- **Setting:** A single, cost-effective, atmospheric location: a hillside ranch-style house lanai in Kalaheo, Kauaʻi, overlooking Poʻipū Bay.
- **Key Scenic Elements:**
 - **Patio Furniture:** High-top bar table and stools.
 - **Tiki Bar:** Strung with Christmas lights and featuring a neon "PAU HANA" sign.
 - **Fire Pit:** Centrally located and used throughout the play for lighting and atmosphere.
 - **Surfboards:** Multiple boards, including a prominently displayed "polished shortboard".
 - **Grounding Elements:** "Slippahs" by the door and lush greenery framing the space.

3. Lighting & Atmosphere

- **Lighting Palette:** Shifts from "Golden Hour" sunset washes to deep torchlight and firelight.
- **Special Effects:**
 - **Isolation Spots:** Used frequently for musicians and specific character monologues (e.g., Blue's songs or Burnzie's "Voice of MIND" transitions).
 - **Torchlight:** In scenes following the global collapse, the stage is lit primarily by torchlight and the flickering fire pit.
 - **Techno-Dread Elements:** Harsh, cold, "unnatural" lighting shifts to denote the presence of the Quantum MIND AI.
 - **Handheld Lights:** The cast carries small individual lights during the final musical number of the Epilogue.

4. Sound & Music Requirements

- **Live Instrumentation Required:** The play relies heavily on integrated live music.
- **Instruments Needed:** Ukulele, Slack Key Guitar, and Box Drum (Cajon).
- **Soundscape:**
 - **Environmental:** Persistent ocean hush, night insects, and wind chimes.
 - **Transitions:** Slack key guitar "reprises" and "aggressive chords" are used to bridge scenes and denote shifts in tension.
 - **Vocal Effects:** Minimal reverb or distortion may be needed for the "flat, detached" voice of the AI MIND.

5. Properties (Props)

- **Hand Props:** Koa bowls for kava, coconut shells, "plates" for kalua pork, wine glasses, and a bottle of champagne.
- **Special Items:**
 - **The "Patch":** Medical patches that characters apply to their skin.
 - **Cultural Items:** Plumeria flowers and a small precious box for Luana's brownies.
 - **Technical Gear:** A monocular for whale watching and a cell phone.

6. Costumes & Movement

- **Wardrobe:** Ranges from casual island wear (boardshorts, faded T-shirts, barefoot) to professional mainland attire (linen sport coats, fedoras, silk wraps) and traditional hula regalia.
- **Movement:** The production requires a performer/choreographer capable of performing traditional **Hula and Hawaiian Chant**.
